Applicants must have an honours degree and will have experience of teaching and research in law in a university environment. Applicants should have a relevant postgraduate degree: preference will be given to those who have completed, or are in the process of completing, a doctorate, and who have refereed publications in areas relevant to the School's fields of endeavour.

The successful candidates will make a substantial contribution to the development and delivery of the School's existing taught programmes, and in the planning and curriculum delivery of future developments in law. Successful candidates will have a firm commitment to excellence in teaching and learning, the continuing enhancement of the student experience, and an understanding of innovative teaching and learning methods.

Successful candidates will also be expected to make a significant contribution to the research profile of the School and the Socio-Legal Research Centre. The successful candidates will be committed to high quality research and publication in well-regarded, academic peer-reviewed journals.
