SOME USEFUL INFORMATION

Please find included some useful links, for those of you who are coming to Dublin, to check before arriving.

1- How to get to DCU?

The Nursing Building is the first building to your left from the main entrance on Collins Avenue.

However, all the buses indicated below stop opposite the Ballymun Road entrance to DCU, so:

Come into the campus gate on Ballymun Road and walk to the end of the avenue – at the end turn left, following the signs for the Helix (past the Albert College, car park 2, the Henry Grattan Building) and keep going on that road till the main (Collins Avenue) entrance where the Nursing Building will be on your right.

Bus tickets are 1.50 euro per passenger, and for those of you staying in the City Centre, from O'Connell St. many buses will take you to DCU:

4, 4a, 4b, 4c, 11, 13, 13a, 19a.

This bus stop is placed across from the Savoy Cinema, near the Carroll's shop. For anyone staying south of the river, the 11, 13, 13a and 19a buses also stop on Westmoreland St, near the corner of Westmoreland St and Fleet St

Allow about 20 – 30 minutes on the bus before you turn onto the Ballymun Road - this is a large dual carriageway. As the bus turns onto it, you will pass a large Esso service station on the left hand side. Alight two stops after the Esso station, you will see the DCU gates across the road.
