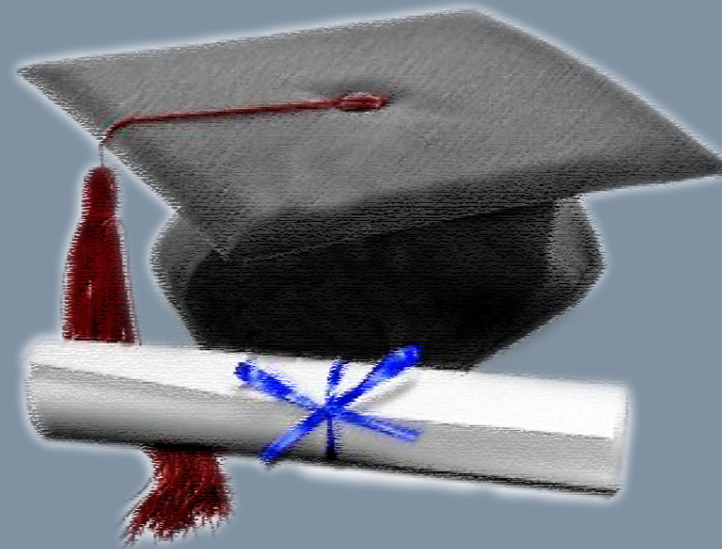
School of Applied Language and Intercultural Studies (SALIS)

- ✓ CV (no longer than 3 pages)
- ✓ Personal statement outlining the applicant's suitability for the scholarship. This should include information on the applicant's background, their interest in the specific MA programme, any relevant experience in the field, and should explain what they hope to achieve by doing the programme.
- ✓ Names and contact details of two referees (at least one from an academic)
